Mercedes-Benz International School was founded in 1998 as a not for profit to serve the needs of a growing expatriate and internationally minded Indian community in a fast-developing Info Tech Park on the outskirts of Pune, Maharashtra. MBIS is accessible by a 3-hour expressway drive from Mumbai or via a small international airport.

THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY

MBIS is academically non-selective, co-educational, and richly diverse with 35 nationalities and an expatriate population of 70%. English is the medium of instruction. Enrollment is stable with 350 students in preschool through the IB Diploma and a waiting list for admission. Many of the 65 teachers hold advanced degrees and are internationally active as IB Examiners, IB Workshop Leaders, and Evaluation/Accreditation visiting team members for NEASC, CIS and the IBO.

CALENDAR

MBIS operates on a semester calendar of 187 instructional days. Semester 1 runs August to December. Semester 2 runs January to June. DP classes are on an 85-minute block schedule with 4 blocks each day.

GRADES, REPORTING AND TEST SCORES

MBIS does not rank nor report individual student GPA on transcripts. Disciplinary action resulting in student off-campus suspension during the last two years, incidents of academic integrity, or any change in student MBIS enrollment status is disclosed according to university expectations either pre or post admission. Continuous assessment without averaging is reported. Assessment and grading is aligned with the IB to allow consistent and reliable prediction of final IB grades:
